Solar Energy Opportunity	Minneapolis Climate Action, plan with Xcel Energy subscribers Michael Krauss: works with Renewable Energy Partners, develops solar projects Every Kw of subscription, receive a bill credit of 9.4/KW Average MN solar garden: 1300 KW per year generation (1 KW of subscription, you would get 1300 KW hour credits) Keep 6.4 cents of bill credit after charge from Renewable Energy Partners Our annual savings projection: 12 KW of subscription available; 12 Kilowatts will generate 1300 KW/year of electricity. Each KW hour will generate bill credit of 9.4 cents; they bill us for 3 cents of the 9.4, so we get a total of 6.4 cents of the credit. Net benefit: \$83/for each KW. Contract is for 25 years. We are looking at 10 shares of purchase for the project. Paid off in 10-12 years, and only benefitting for the remainder of the contract. \$9500 investment now for savings later. Building Foundation Repair Project	Lots of federal pandemic funding (ESSR funds) to come in future years. Added conservative assumptions on materials to be bought. Adjusted salaries, putting in specific numbers for known hires. Brought salaries and benefits down in CARES Act expenditures. Have used CARES Act funding to supplement some of salaries, for intervention/ADSIS teachers, etc. Not using CARES Act funding for summer school. Still have \$279k unbudgeted, without touching ESSR 3 yet (pushed to next year), and with conservative enrollment assumptions. Also \$256k surplus, with salary adjustments, staffing changes etc. Adjusting surplus down to \$100k. What are the CARES Act supplements to the budget; what are the things we know we are going to use the money for? What is the total number of unbudgeted amount for the duration/this year? Decision-making/process for when we need this info moving forward? Some cracks in foundation; quote on sealing cracks. Have received 3 different quotes; want to go with most expensive quote because we want to solve the problem so we can expand in the basement. Have money in the budget; need place to do it by July 1.
